

# How did 15 Days start?

In the late 1990's and 2000's several editions of a longer prayer guide for Hindu peoples helped Christians understand and pray for Hindu communities around the world. In 2016, a network of Christians working to share the love of Christ with Hindu people were inspired to work towards reviving that prayer movement by developing this prayer guide to call the global Body of Christ to unite in prayer for Hindu peoples.

This 2020 edition is an expression of the love that followers of Christ have for Hindu peoples; love that includes a desire for them to prosper and discover eternal salvation in Jesus.
