We have been planning and preparing for this project for a few years now, so we are absolutely delighted to be able to share with you that sufficient funds have now been raised for us to begin this work.

The project includes a new welcoming entrance on the south side of the church and new glazed links between the church and existing community hall.

The church family has donated over £165,000 and a further £155,000 has been pledged as grants!
